

St Joseph's College, Albany Bring Your Own Digital Device for 2024

The following guidelines will help you purchase a device for your child in the junior or secondary school. Students in Year Six to Twelve **MUST HAVE** their own device for 2024.

Your chosen device must meet <u>all</u> of the following requirements:

Form Factor	Laptop, Tablet or Convertible Device	
Physical Dimensions	Minimum Screen Size: 9.7"	
Supported Operating Systems	Microsoft Windows 10 or 11 macOS (iOS, Android and Chromebook NOT compatible)	
Input Device	Keyboard with Touchpad (Tablets must have a keyboard accessory)	
Battery Life	Minimum of 6 hours advertised battery life. It is recommended the device supports charging via USB-C, this will ensure it is compatible with charging stations available at the College.	
RAM	Minimum of 8GB	
Hard Disk	Solid State Drive, minimum of 128GB capacity	

Other Essential Requirements:

Protection	A hard case, or bag
Insurance	Accidental Loss and or Breakage Insurance – parents must organise this through the retailer or on their own home policy.

Software Requirements

The St Joseph's College IT Department will install all required software when configuring your device for the network.
