

MIDDLE SCHOOL NEWS

Immunisations for Year 7 Students

The 2010 WA School Based Immunisation Programme will be offered at the College by Great Southern Population Health Immunisation Team

All female students in Year 7 will be offered:

 A 3 dose course of Human Papilloma virus (HPV) vaccine

MIDDLE SCHOOL NEWS

All Year 7 students will be offered:

- A two-dose course of Hepatitis B vaccine given in terms 1 and 3
- One dose of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine given in term 2

Chicken pox disease can be mild, with only a few spots. If your child has not had chicken pox disease or chicken pox vaccine then they are eligible for the vaccine.

 One dose of diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine (whooping cough) given in term 3

These vaccines will be offered over 4 visits. Vaccination Consent forms have been sent home with students. Parents/legal guardians are asked to complete and sign the forms and return them to the College. Even if you are not consenting to your child receiving the vaccines, please still return the form.

If you do not receive a Vaccination Consent form, please ask at the College Office for one. We need all the immunisation forms returned to school by **Monday 8 February**, for checking. If you have any queries regarding the immunisation programme please contact me on 98427511.

If your child is not vaccinated at school, they can go to a local immunisation clinic at 125 Grey Street West Albany, (free vaccine and service). Phone 98427500 to make an appointment.


