## From the Principal



Dear Parents, Guardians, Families, Students and Members of our College Community.

This week the College marked the beginning of Lent with a Mass on Ash Wednesday.

Lent is a very important season in the Church where it is marked by fasting, prayer and almsgiving. On Fridays during Lent we do not sell meat products in our canteen. For almsgiving, our focus is on raising money for Caritas Australia - you will be hearing more about this.

After the Ash Wednesday Mass we held a brief College assembly.

The purpose of this assembly was to present our Year Twelve students with their Seniors Badges - an Edmund Rice badge for the boys and a Sisters of St Joseph of the Apparition badge for the girls.



The badges remind our students they are continuing in the footsteps of the founders of the religious orders, St Emilie De Vialar and Blessed Edmund Rice, that led to the sending of Sisters and Brothers from their homes in France and Ireland to places like Albany. These people made a huge difference to the lives of others, they were truly people of service: wearing this badge reminds our seniors and school leaders that they are also people of service.

### Parents of 4 Year Olds - Immunisations

Children who have turned 4 years of age are scheduled to receive 2 injections, MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) and DTP – IPV (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Whooping Cough, and Polio) vaccines. These are booster doses to ensure good levels of coverage against these life threatening diseases. These immunisations can now be given as early as 3.5 years of age.

From 1 July 2012, families will need to have their children fully immunized or have an approved exemption to receive the Family Tax Benefit Part A end-of-year supplement.

The supplement, worth \$726 per child each year, will now only be paid once a child is fully immunised at one, two and five years of age, or has an approved exemption.

This means that over the three immunisation check points, families will have an incentive of more than \$2,100.

If your child still requires his/her immunisations please see your usual immunisation provider or alternatively you are welcome to make an appointment for our Tuesday / Thursday Grey Street Albany immunisation clinic. This is a free service, and appointments can be made by phoning 98427500.
